- **Welcome-** Review and approve minutes from the March meeting. Motion done by Kristi Perreault and Sarah Riechers seconded.
- **PTO Report**
  1. Introductions, welcome remarks.
- **Treasurer's Report – Jennifer Walczak-** Expenses and balances reviewed; A copy of the report was available to attendees during the meeting. It will be available to the public on the PTO website.
  1. Cash register balance: \$11, 717.55; Encumbered funds \$13, 450
  2. Successful Fun Run! Final financial details coming soon.
- **Principal's Report- Dr. Bock**
  1. We are ~60% in person now. Getting a lot of requests for 4 days in person. Considering distancing and mitigation in decision whether to approve the requests. Over 40 requests pending as of Friday.
  2. SOLs: Grade 3-5 are eligible to take tests in reading and math, 5<sup>th</sup> grade also in science. 4<sup>th</sup> grade VA studies is not being tested via SOL. Options for in-person, remote alternative VA testing, and opting out of testing. Still questions about 5<sup>th</sup> graders going into 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Currently the county is saying that SOL opt-out of 5<sup>th</sup> graders WILL NOT impact math placement for 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Test will occur in May.
  3. New assistant principal: Michael Dugger.
    - a. His remarks: Extremely excited. Official start date April 19.
  4. Financial Update: CARES Act funding available to support extension remediation, TTAs, summer school offerings. Budget is in good shape coming into 21-22 school year.

5. Question: What student characteristics are you prioritizing for 4 day in-person learning?  
At this point we're looking at space and student needs. High response level right now.
